

How to Order a Roll Off Container for Renovation / Demolition / Cleanup

Why Are They Called "Roll Off" Containers?

If you're a homeowner who is renting a roll off trash container for the first time, you may be wondering where the term "**roll off**" came from. Roll off containers actually go by many names: trash containers, garbage containers, waste containers, roll off boxes, roll off bins, trash bins, dumpster containers, dumpster enclosures, debris boxes, and more. **The term "roll off" simply comes from the fact that the container rolls off the back of a truck onto your driveway or job site.**

Determining the Size of the Roll Off Container Needed

Roll Off containers are available in sizes from 10cy to 40cy. Imagine the truck bed of a compact pickup truck; its capacity is about 1¼cy, compared to a 10cy roll off that would be equal to 8 truckloads. The capacity in the bed of a full size pickup truck is a little over 2cy; it would take 5 truckloads to equal a 10cy roll off.

10cy Roll Off

Is appropriate for a small basement or garage cleanout; yard debris cleanup, or a small kitchen & bath remodeling job.

20cy Roll Off

Is good for a large basement, attic, or garage cleanup; flooring and carpet removal for a large house.

30cy Roll Off

For your major home addition; construction of a new home; demolition of a garage; or entire house window or siding replacement for a small to medium size home.

40cy Roll Off

Would be best for window or siding replacement for a large home; commercial roof tear off; commercial cleanout; new construction, demolition or major addition; large amount of trash, paper, or cardboard.

Type of Waste Debris and Disposal Sites Acceptable / Restricted Waste

In helping our Island to become sustainable, we must be responsible in disposing our waste debris to the appropriate disposal site. When ordering your roll off container we will ask you a few questions regarding the type of waste debris you are planning on disposing of due to the strict regulations imposed by the State and C&C of Honolulu. The following disposal sites are where we will take your

waste debris. Depending on your “mix” of waste debris, it may be determined that it has to be separated and placed in different roll off containers.

Waimanalo Gulch Landfill & H-Power (Waste to Energy):

Acceptable: Household material which consists of trash bags, books, magazines, plastic toys, clothes, some wood, cardboard/paper and other every day trash.

Restricted: Hazardous materials (tires/batteries/appliances/oil/solvents/wet paint/fuel, etc.), e-waste (computers/CPU/TV/monitors), green waste, wooden pallets and construction material.

Waimanalo Gulch Landfill will accept mattresses, box springs but no bed frames with an additional special handling fee.

Hawaiian Earth Products:

Acceptable: Trees cut 3'-4' length, grass, branches, trimmings, leaves and untreated/unpainted wood.

Restricted: Hazardous materials (tires/batteries/appliances/oil/solvents/wet paint/fuel, etc.), e-waste (computers/CPU/TV/monitors), household trash, cardboard, any type of fiber/paper, plastic bags, painted or treated wood and construction material.

PVT Landfill Company:

Acceptable: Construction and demolition material, tile, concrete, wood, metal, rebar, dry wall, dirt, asphalt, roofing, flooring, carpets.

Restricted: Hazardous materials (tires/batteries/appliances/oil/solvents/wet paint/fuel, etc.), e-waste (computers/CPU/TV/monitors), household trash and green waste.

Positioning Your Roll Off Container

Height, length and width clearance is important in the delivery of your roll off container. We need a minimum height clearance of 21', 65' of straight access and 15' in width to stage your roll off container. Please do not block access to the roll off container when we are there to pick it up. There may be additional charges if we have to stand by until we have access to the roll off. If your roll off container is to be placed on a public street or causeway, you will need a street permit from the C&C of Honolulu first before delivery. We ask that the roll off container be placed on a hard / level surface. If you want to protect the surface from damages we ask that you provide wooden planks at least 6' long to be placed under each wheel.

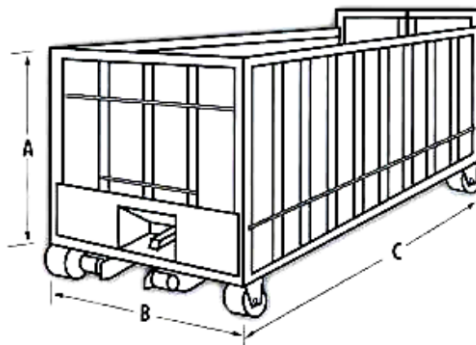
A full roll off container is quite heavy, so we ask that you do not go over the weight limit of 10 tons of any type of debris and have it evenly distributed within the container. Some of the heaviest material is dirt and concrete which at 1cy equals approximately one ton. There may be additional charges if the container goes over the 10-ton limit. The loading height is the sides of the roll off container

and we ask that you do not go over that limit. If the container is overloaded we will ask that you down load the debris from the container before we pick it up for disposal.

All waste debris listed above has to be kept separate by each disposal site; if it is mixed into one roll off container and rejected at the designated landfill, there will be additional charges.

How to Order a Roll Off Container

- 1.) Call 808-845-7581 and your call will be answered by one of our Customer Service Representatives.
- 2.) Ask to speak with someone in the Sales Department to order a roll off.
- 3.) Inform the sales personnel of your request with the following information readily available.
 - a. Name
 - b. Address of location.
 - c. Type of material being disposed of.
 - d. Size of roll off container
- 4.) Our sales personnel will take down this information and send out one of our sales representatives to do a site check and possibly meet with you to go over the details of getting your roll off container delivered. We do the site check for safety and accessibility.
- 5.) Costs will be quoted and if approved we will deliver your roll off container within 24 - 48 hours.
